SSS Analysis- 2023-24

The institution has adopted the Students Satisfaction Survey as per the guidelines of NAAC. It adopted the same questionnaire suggested by NAAC. There are twenty objective questions and one open ended question. The responses are in the scale of 4 to 0, with the most positive response rated as 4 and most negative response rated as 0. Total 60 students were provided the questionnaire randomly from all classes. They were asked to tick the most appropriate response to the questions.
